




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Free Community Program: Jam Sessions

For a teenager in a music therapy Jam Session group, music provides a real-life way to connect with the community in a rock band format while working on social skills.

**Jam Session Overview** 



- **Purpose**: to provide a music therapy and mentoring program for 20 youth with special needs through one-hour music therapy groups (aka as "Jam Sessions") at a local community venue to promote **socialization**, **emotional** expression, community inclusion and communication.
- Help teen/young adult become more independent
- Functional impact on their lives
- Measure social skill progress through standardized assessment for grant funding
